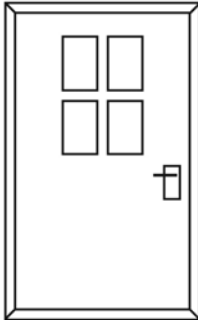

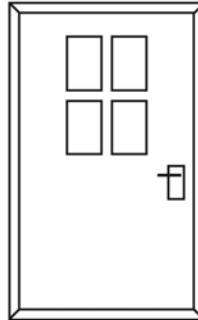

## Narrative



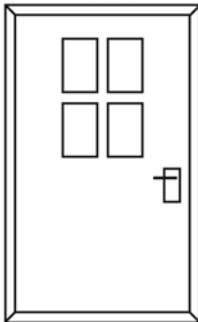
- Tell a story.

## Logical/Quantitative



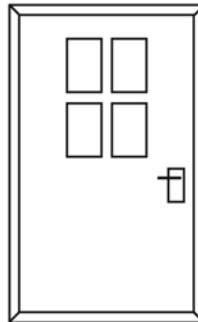
- Outline the main points.
- Show and analyze a graph, chart, or map.
- Use relevant examples.
- Introduce concepts with a graphic organizer.

## Foundational



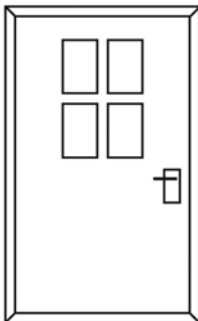
- Explain the theory.
- Categorize the ideas.
- Show the context through a timeline.
- Address the big questions.

## Aesthetic



- Show a photograph or piece of art.
- Play a song.
- Watch a dramatic production or video.
- Consider examples for their artistic properties.

## Experiential



- Introduce through role play or gestures.
- Play a relevant game.
- Do an experiment.
- Provide relevant resources for students to touch and manipulate.
